Stayman III: After 2NT Opening

After partner opens 2NT (20-21 balanced), the Stayman convention is used via a 3 response to find a 4-4 major fit. Generally a major fit plays better than NT. The point needed for Stayman over 2NT opening are less than Stayman over 1NT. The 3 response asks opener to bid a 4-card major or deny such a holding by bidding 3. Both of these bids are artificial but so common no alert is necessary.

Requirements

With rare exceptions, here are the minimum requirements for using Stayman after Partner Opens 2NT:

- ☐ 5+ points
- ☐ At least one 4-card major
- ☐ At least one short suit, i.e., a doubleton

Specified Responses

Opener Rebid	Meaning				
3♦	Opener lacks a 4+card major				
3♥	Opener has 4-card ♥ suit; may have 4-card ♠				
3♠	Opener has 4-card ♠ suit only				

There are no game invitational sequences after a 2NT/Stayman auction, as there are with a 1NT opening.

Responder Rebids (5+)

Responder rebids 3NT without a 4-4 major fit, unless Responder has a 5-card major and a 4-card major. In the case of 5-4 in the majors, Responder bids the 4-card major, which must be alerted by Opener. This is the Smolen convention.

Stayman with an unbalanced Weak Hand (Under 5 points)

With an unbalanced weak hand, there are two hand distributions with which Responder may use Stayman over 2NT: when holding at least 4 cards in ♠, ♥, and ♦, which leaves zero or one card in ♣s. Note: With a weak hand and 5+cards in a major, use Jacoby Transfer and Pass.

For example, with ♠J742 ♥ T963 ♦T942 ♠ 3 use Stayman but Pass any bid Opener makes. This is called "Garbage Stayman."

After Other 2NT Bids

Opener jumps to 2NT after opening a minor: New Minor Forcing is on; Responder needs more points for game as Opener promises 18-19.

Opener rebids 2NT after opening 24: Stayman is on; Responder needs less points.
