A recommended evaluation system for advancing players; more aggressive than Seagram's, as it counts length and shortness for dummy after an 8+card fit is found. Refinements may be added in future editions.

## **Process:**

- 1. Initial valuation: Add HCP and Length points; make Adjustment(s)
- 2. <u>After fit is found</u>: Add for Shortness and extra Declarer trump length

## **Point Count System:**

<sup>(1)</sup> No adjustment if Partner shows opening balanced 1NT+ values

<sup>(2)</sup> No adjustment if Partner bid suit

<sup>(3)</sup> Do not count Q&J's in a suit with 4+Honors

## **Opening Hands:**

- Open Rule of 20 hands (all seats)
- Open all 15 HCP balanced hands with 1NT (no adjustment)
- Open light in third seat (10-11 points) when:
  - ✓ enjoying favorable vulnerability and wanting your suit led
  - $\checkmark$  holding 7+cards in the majors.
