Getting to Know...

PHYLLIS and DICK WASSERSTROM

Phyllis and Dick Wasserstrom have lived in Santa Cruz for 44 years. Dick is a retired professor of Philosophy at UC Santa Cruz. Phyllis is retired from what was the Santa Cruz Counseling Center, where she counseled youths.

Dick started to play bridge by watching his parents; he also played a bit in college. He says he has probably been playing thirty years. Both he and Phyllis dabbled in party bridge; they started playing duplicate bridge here at the SCBC in 2003 and 2004.
